REGULATIONS

1. Copy of **Way Bill** and **Indemnity Form** must be handed to the Show Secretary on arrival.
2. Stall bookings must be prepaid. \$5 per stall or \$7 per stallion stall. For bookings contact Mrs A Bettridge on 07 4985 3400.
3. Electric fences can be erected on the western side of the paddock fence off the camping area. The fee of \$10 for erection of electric fences must be paid to the Secretary prior to the start of the show.
4. **HELMETS** must be worn at all times whilst riding. This includes costume classes. All junior competitors are reminded of the mandatory ruling requiring the compulsory wearing of AS/NZS 3838 or EN 7384 or ASTN F1163 helmets in all phases. This ruling will be enforced with **NO** exceptions.
5. Competitors must be correctly attired in all classes.
6. Ponies may be led by an adult or child, but **not** ridden by an adult.
7. No stallions shall compete in Hack events or riding events unless otherwise stated.
8. Stallions must be lead by person 17 years and over.
9. Children's age will be taken as of Monday, the first day of the show.
10. Lady or Gentleman rider means rider must be 17 years old by the first day of the show.
11. Children under the age of 14 years of age **CANNOT** compete in Ring 1.
12. A junior rider 14 years and over competing in Ring 1 can compete in the Rider Class in Ring 2 on the same horse. This is the only class a junior rider can compete in on the same horse in 2 different classes. Junior riders may compete on another horse in Ring 2 but neither Ring will be held up for any competitor competing in both rings.
13. Mounts ridden in Ring 1 by a Senior Riders, 17 years and over, may not be ridden in Ring 2 by a Junior Rider under 17 years. Mounts ridden in Ring 2 by a Junior Rider may not be ridden by a Senior Rider in Ring 1.
14. A novice horse is one that has never won a championship ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
15. A maiden horse is one that has never won a blue ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
16. A novice rider is one that has never won a championship ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
17. Classes for local hack events are confined to Competitors who have resided in the Alpha/Jericho District for the previous 6 months minimum.
18. Competitors nominated in 2 rings where times clash must make a choice of which event they are to compete in, and, with the exception of championships, events will not be held up for late riders under any circumstances.
19. Lodgement of a completed entry form will be taken as a guarantee that the animals specified therein are free from all disease as far as is known by the owner and/or exhibitor. In the case of an infectious disease being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be held responsible.
20. The Alpha Show Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold Alpha Show Society Inc. blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.
21. Alpha Show Society Inc., will not, under any circumstances, hold itself liable for any accident on the ground.

Conditions

22. Protests **must** be lodged in writing to the Secretary within one (1) hour after the awarding dispute has been made. A protest fee of \$5.00 is required and will be retained by the Society if in the opinion of the executive the protest is frivolous.
23. Stock, where practicable, shall be paraded as directed by the Ring Master. Exhibitor's who do not comply, may be fined and disqualified at the discretion of the Ring Master, whose decision will be final. All prizes won by said exhibitors shall be retained by the Society.
24. The age of all horses are to be calculated as from 1 August. Every horse foaled before 1 August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date.
25. Any animal which, in the opinion of the Stewards is not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by then, and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered. Any animal rejected must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.
26. All horses entered for competition in stud classes must be registered in a stud book of their respective breed society recognised by the Royal National Association. Registration papers (or copies) must be produced upon request where breed regulations require, nominations must be accompanied by breeding details.
27. Horses entered in any class for which a prescribed height is a condition, **MUST** be measured by the official measurer who will issue Competitors with a receipt to be produced upon request. **THIS CLAUSE APPLIES TO NOMINATIONS IN BOTH RINGS.**
28. The committee reserves the right to add classes as deemed necessary to cater for unexpected interest in particular breed classes.

Measuring

29. Measuring of horses, galloways and ponies will commence Monday afternoon. Official EFAQ Measuring Card/Show Horse Committee Queensland Cards will NOT be accepted. To maintain uniformity, the measuring stick from the Emerald Show Society will be used. An allowance of 3/8" is made for shoes. Measuring Cards issued at the Alpha Show will be the only one's recognised at this and all shows on the Central Highlands circuit. Entry into either ring may be denied without a height card.
30. Ponies classes not to exceed 14 hh. (Except registered Australian Saddle Ponies).
Registered Australian Saddle Ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh. Galloways range 14–15 hh.

Judging

31. When there are insufficient numbers for competition, at the Judges discretion horses will be classified into weight classes immediately prior to the event.
32. No person except those engaged in charge of the exhibit shall be permitted to remain in the yards or ring during judging.
33. Stock appearing in the ring for judging will be disqualified if same are decorated with medals, ribbons, or prize tickets awarded at previous shows or events.
34. Geldings unless otherwise required by the various breed societies, are not eligible for Champion Male, but will have their own Championship at the end of the breeds exhibits for which they are eligible.
35. Champion Mare/Filly of each section breed/society and Champion Led Pony Mare/Filly will compete for Supreme Champion Mare/Filly. Champion Stallion/Colt of each breed/section and Champion Led Pony Stallion/Colt will compete for Supreme Champion Stallion/Colt.
36. Where there is a Grand Champion for each breed, points will not be accumulated for Aggregate Trophy. No points will be counted towards Aggregate Trophy for Supreme Led Exhibit. Otherwise points for Aggregate trophies are calculated as follows:
Ø 9 points - Supreme Champion; Ø 7 points – Champion; Ø 5 points - Reserve Champion;
Ø 3 points – First; Ø 2 points – Second; Ø 1 point - Third
In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place and the next lower place shall be equally divided.
37. The Judge may at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is in the opinion, not of sufficient merit.

Grand Parade

38. Any exhibitor's who fails to parade their exhibit in the Grand Parade, may at the discretion of the Chief Steward forfeit all prize money/trophies won.
39. Trophies will be presented during the Grand Parade on Wednesday.

Departure

40. ALL STOCK travelling West of Alpha **MUST** be sprayed at the sale yards before leaving the Alpha area.

- ◆ To be ridden in a Snaffle Bit and with both hands. Transitions from one place to another may be progressive, except where stated otherwise.
- ◆ Penalties for errors over the course: 1st error – 2 marks, 2nd error – 4 marks, 3rd error – 8 marks, 4th error – Elimination.
- ◆ Caller allowed.
- ◆ Horses competing in classes 1 & 2 are ineligible for classes 3 & 4.
